

Battery - Installation

WARNING

Before starting work, ensure the motorcycle is stabilised and adequately supported. This will help prevent it from falling and causing injury to the operator or damage to the motorcycle.

WARNING

Ensure that the battery terminals do not touch the motorcycle frame as this may cause a short circuit or spark, which would ignite battery gases causing a risk of personal injury.

1. Place the battery in the battery case and secure with the battery strap.
2. Secure with the battery strap and make sure the USB port socket is refitted.
3. Reconnect the battery, positive (red) lead first and tighten the battery terminals to **4.5 Nm**.
4. Apply a light coat of grease to the terminals to prevent corrosion.
5. Cover the positive terminal with the protective cap.
6. Refit the seat (see [Seat - Installation](#)).
